Selection criteria

Contributors are asked to address the integration of transport and land-use planning through interesting and original research results and examples of good practice. Papers should show a direct link to policy, such as research for policy development and/or to assess the effectiveness of policy initiatives and monitoring procedures. Issues to be addressed are set out in the Call for Papers of the **Planning for Sustainable Land-Use and Transport Programme Committee**.

In conclusion, the jury considered the following criteria in its decision process:

1. Integration of transport and planning disciplines
2. Relevance to the call for papers
3. Originality of thought
4. Linkage to policy

The award will be conferred during the European Transport Conference 2010 which will be held in Glasgow, Scotland, 11-13 October 2010!
