### **Call for Papers**

**Deadline: 5 February 2010**

The focus of this committee is on safety research, policy and implementation; incident management; risk and liability and traffic engineering.

Themes for ETC 2010 are:

- Strategy and policy: targets and visions; supranational (worldwide) and pan-European safety studies, benchmarks on safety risks management at international, national and local authority level
- Infrastructure safety: planning and implementation; safety considerations in urban planning, route hierarchy and trip planning, before after studies
- Safety technology: ITS; information, detection and control
- Speed and enforcement
- Road user behaviour and attitudes: research and consultation; with particular interest in vulnerable road user safety: pedestrian, cyclists, motorcyclists; the young and the elderly
- the way the diversity of traffic is taken in consideration : particularly mixture of powered 2 wheelers, cyclist and pedestrians, HGV's in infrastructure design either urban or interurban, with new concepts as shared space, slow fluidity, opening reserved lanes to different users, consequences on safety and traffic management.
- Emergency and evacuation planning
- Commercial vehicle safety
- Accident data and analysis: safety evaluation, simulation and visualisation; conflicts, causation and trends
- Active Traffic Management (ATM) - improving traffic flow and reducing congestion on motorways through automatic systems and human intervention to manage traffic flow and ensure the safety of road users
- Pedestrian flows and engineering and safety measures
- Linking safety to other domains like sustainability, accessibility or traffic management
