The Leisure and Tourism Transport committee would welcome any papers related to the theoretical, operational and policy issues generated by the operation of transport services for leisure and tourism purposes. This includes issues related to the transit journey between the tourist destination and the tourist generating country or region and also the planning and accommodation of tourist journeys within the destination area.

In 2010 the committee would specifically welcome papers on:

- **Transport planning and transport services for major sporting and cultural events**
In particular we would welcome case studies relating to 2010 World Cup, 2012 Olympics and 2014 Commonwealth Games.
- **Policies and approaches to generate leisure and tourism growth in a sustainable way**
We would welcome case studies to reduce car dependency for domestic tourism and day trips and studies on the development of 'Green Travel Plans' by Tourist Attractions and other destination organisations.
- **International tourism and aviation**
We would welcome papers exploring tourism's contribution to GHG emissions and approaches to accommodate growth whilst seeking to meet emission reduction targets.
- **The impact of seasonality on the planning and provision of transport services and transport infrastructure**
- **The providing and marketing of services for tourists in major cities**
